This film was created as a part of a documentary workshop course at Temple University. All of the education and collaboration I have had the privilege of experiencing as a Temple student helped make this film what it is.



Because People Are Interesting (2023) | Another self-directed documentary, this short film provides a unique window into the lives of the citizens of Philadelphia and Temple University through the introduction of a certain theoretical question.



Freedom of the Press (2017) | *Freedom of the Press* is the first student documentary I produced in high school that covers the different challenges journalists face in the modern world, particularly under the Trump administration.
